

Christmas Addition Word Problems (Within 20) - Answer Key

1st Grade - Christmas addition word problems within 20 | 12 minutes

Read each problem. Add the two numbers and write the answer.

Example: 7 red ornaments and 6 gold ornaments: $7 + 6 = 13$ ornaments.

1. There are 7 red ornaments and 6 gold ornaments. How many ornaments in all?

Answer: $7 + 6 = 13$ ornaments

2. Sam wrapped 9 gifts, then wrapped 5 more. How many gifts did he wrap?

Answer: $9 + 5 = 14$ gifts

3. A plate had 8 cookies. Mom added 7 more. How many cookies now?

Answer: $8 + 7 = 15$ cookies

4. There are 6 candy canes on the tree and 8 on the table. How many candy canes?

Answer: $6 + 8 = 14$ candy canes

5. Ana sent 9 cards and got 9 cards back. How many cards in all?

Answer: $9 + 9 = 18$ cards

6. 4 elves and 7 reindeer are in the barn. How many in all?

Answer: $4 + 7 = 11$

Challenge

7. You had 12 cookies and baked 6 more. How many cookies do you have now?

Answer: $12 + 6 = 18$ cookies

8. There are 10 lights on the tree and 8 on the door. How many lights?

Answer: $10 + 8 = 18$ lights
