

Doubles and Doubles Plus One Worksheet - Answer Key

1st Grade - doubles and doubles-plus-one strategy | 10 minutes

Add. Use a doubles fact to help. A doubles-plus-one is the double and one more.

Example: $6 + 7$: $6 + 6 = 12$, and one more is 13. So $6 + 7 = 13$.

1. $4 + 4 =$

Answer: 8

2. $6 + 6 =$

Answer: 12

3. $8 + 8 =$

Answer: 16

4. $4 + 5 =$

Answer: 9

5. $6 + 7 =$

Answer: 13

6. $7 + 8 =$

Answer: 15

7. $5 + 5 =$

Answer: 10

8. $5 + 6 =$

Answer: 11

9. $9 + 9 =$

Answer: 18

10. $3 + 4 =$

Answer: 7

Challenge

11. Use a double to solve $8 + 9$. Which double helps?

Answer: $8 + 8 = 16$, plus one more = 17

12. Why is $6 + 7$ one more than $6 + 6$?

Answer: Because 7 is one more than 6, so the sum is one more.
