

Make a Ten to Add Worksheet - Answer Key

1st Grade - make-a-ten addition strategy | 10 minutes

Add by making a ten first. Fill one number up to 10, then add what is left.

Example: $8 + 5$: 8 needs 2 to make 10; 3 are left; $10 + 3 = 13$.

1. $8 + 5 =$

Answer: 13

2. $9 + 4 =$

Answer: 13

3. $7 + 6 =$

Answer: 13

4. $8 + 6 =$

Answer: 14

5. $9 + 5 =$

Answer: 14

6. $7 + 5 =$

Answer: 12

7. $8 + 7 =$

Answer: 15

8. $9 + 6 =$

Answer: 15

Challenge

9. Show how to make a ten to solve $8 + 5$.

Answer: $8 + 2 = 10$, then $10 + 3 = 13$

10. How many more does 7 need to make 10?

Answer: 3
