

Comparing Numbers Worksheet (Greater Than, Less Than) - Answer Key

1st Grade - comparing two-digit numbers | 12 minutes

Write $>$, $<$, or $=$ between each pair of numbers. Compare the tens first.

Example: $34 \underline{\quad} 43$: 3 tens is less than 4 tens, so $34 < 43$.

1. $34 \underline{\quad} 43$

Answer: $<$

2. $56 \underline{\quad} 56$

Answer: $=$

3. $28 \underline{\quad} 19$

Answer: $>$

4. $71 \underline{\quad} 75$

Answer: $<$

5. $60 \underline{\quad} 16$

Answer: $>$

6. $45 \underline{\quad} 54$

Answer: $<$

7. $88 \underline{\quad} 88$

Answer: $=$

8. $32 \underline{\quad} 23$

Answer: $>$

Challenge

9. Write a number that is greater than 50.

Answer: Answers will vary, e.g. 62.

10. Which is greater, 47 or 74? How do you know?

Answer: 74 - it has 7 tens, while 47 has only 4 tens.
