

1st Grade Fractions: Halves and Fourths - Answer Key

1st Grade - partitioning into halves and fourths (equal shares) | 12 minutes

Each bar is split into equal parts. Write whether the parts are halves or fourths.

Example: A bar split into 2 equal parts shows halves. A bar split into 4 equal parts shows fourths.

Challenge

7. Which is bigger: one half of a pizza or one fourth of the same pizza?

Answer: One half - fewer parts means each piece is bigger.

8. How many fourths make one whole?

Answer: 4 fourths make one whole.
