**Answer: sh (ship)**

2. \_\_\_in (under your mouth)

**Answer: ch (chin)**

3. ba\_\_\_ (you wash in it)

**Answer: th (bath)**

4. \_\_\_ale (a big sea animal)

**Answer: wh (whale)**

5. \_\_\_op (a store)

**Answer: sh (shop)**

6. \_\_\_eese (a yellow food)

**Answer: ch (cheese)**

7. \_\_\_umb (on your hand)

**Answer: th (thumb)**

8. \_\_\_eel (it rolls)

**Answer: wh (wheel)**

9. Say the sound 'sh' makes. Name a word that starts with it.

**Answer: The /sh/ sound; answers vary, e.g. shoe, shell, shark.**
