Part A: circle the adjective in each sentence. Part B: choose the adjective that best completes the sentence.

Example: The tall giraffe ate leaves. -> tall (tells what kind of giraffe)

Answer: tall | ② Three kittens slept in the basket.
Answer: Three |
| ③ The soft blanket kept us warm.
Answer: soft | ④ A loud bell rang in the hallway.
Answer: loud |
| ⑤ We picked ripe apples at the farm.
Answer: ripe | ⑥ The old wooden bridge crossed the river.
Answer: old, wooden |
| ⑦ Choose the best adjective: It was a (sunny / glass) day.
Answer: sunny | ⑧ Choose the best adjective: The puppy was (round / playful).
Answer: playful |
| ⑨ Choose the best adjective: He wore a (warm / running) jacket.
Answer: warm | ⑩ Choose the best adjective: The (blue / chair) lake sparkled.
Answer: blue |
| ⑪ Choose the best adjective: My soup is (tasty / pencil).
Answer: tasty | ⑫ Choose the best adjective: A (noisy / kitchen) crowd cheered.
Answer: noisy |

- ⑬ Add two adjectives to this sentence: The dog ran.
Answer: Sample: The big, brown dog ran.
- ⑭ Which word tells more about the lake: 'The blue lake sparkled' - blue or lake?
Answer: blue - it tells what kind of lake
