Rewrite each sentence, replacing the underlined noun with the correct pronoun: he, she, it, we, or they.

Example: Maria ran fast. -> She ran fast.

1. Tom plays soccer. (Tom)

Answer: He plays soccer.

2. Mom is cooking. (Mom)

Answer: She is cooking.

3. The dog barked loudly. (The dog)

Answer: It barked loudly.

4. Sam and I went home. (Sam and I)

Answer: We went home.

5. The children are playing. (The children)

Answer: They are playing.

6. Grandpa told a story. (Grandpa)

Answer: He told a story.

7. The apple fell down. (The apple)

Answer: It fell down.

8. My friends came over. (My friends)

Answer: They came over.

9. Why do we use pronouns instead of repeating a name?
