

Money Word Problems Worksheet - Answer Key

2nd Grade - money word problems | 15 minutes

Read each problem and solve. Remember the coin values: quarter 25, dime 10, nickel 5, penny 1. Write your answer in cents.

Example: Sara has 3 dimes and 2 nickels: $30 + 10 = 40$ cents.

1. Sara has 3 dimes and 2 nickels. How much money does she have?

Answer: $30 + 10 = 40$ cents

2. A pencil costs 45 cents. Tom pays with 2 quarters. How much change?

Answer: $50 - 45 = 5$ cents

3. Mia has 2 quarters, 1 dime, and 3 pennies. How much in all?

Answer: $50 + 10 + 3 = 63$ cents

4. An eraser is 30 cents. You pay with 50 cents. How much change?

Answer: $50 - 30 = 20$ cents

5. Jon has 4 dimes and 1 quarter. How much money does he have?

Answer: $40 + 25 = 65$ cents

6. A sticker costs 20 cents. How much do 3 stickers cost?

Answer: $20 + 20 + 20 = 60$ cents

Challenge

7. You have 75 cents. You buy a juice for 60 cents. How much change do you get?

Answer: $75 - 60 = 15$ cents

8. How many nickels make 25 cents?

Answer: 5 nickels ($5 \times 5 = 25$)
