

Number Bonds Worksheet - Answer Key

2nd Grade - part-part-whole number bonds | 10 minutes

Find the missing number in each number bond. The whole is the big number; the parts add to it.

Example: Whole 10, parts 6 and ____: $10 - 6 = 4$, so the missing part is 4.

1. Whole is 10. One part is 6. What is the other part?

Answer: 4

2. Whole is 14. One part is 8. What is the other part?

Answer: 6

3. Whole is 12. One part is 5. What is the other part?

Answer: 7

4. The parts are 9 and 7. What is the whole?

Answer: 16

5. Whole is 20. One part is 13. What is the other part?

Answer: 7

6. Whole is 15. One part is 6. What is the other part?

Answer: 9

7. The parts are 8 and 8. What is the whole?

Answer: 16

8. Whole is 18. One part is 9. What is the other part?

Answer: 9

Challenge

9. There are 13 crayons. 8 are red and the rest are blue. How many are blue?

Answer: $13 - 8 = 5$ blue crayons

10. Write two parts that make a whole of 10.

Answer: Answers will vary, e.g. 3 and 7.
