

Division Word Problems Worksheet - Answer Key

3rd Grade - division word problems | 16 minutes

Read each problem. Write a division sentence and solve. Label your answer.

Example: 24 cookies shared equally by 6 friends -> $24 \div 6 = 4$ cookies each.

1. 24 cookies are shared equally among 6 friends. How many cookies does each friend get?

Answer: $24 \div 6 = 4$ cookies

2. A teacher puts 30 books on 5 shelves with the same number on each. How many books per shelf?

Answer: $30 \div 5 = 6$ books

3. There are 18 wheels. Each bike has 2 wheels. How many bikes are there?

Answer: $18 \div 2 = 9$ bikes

4. 42 students form 6 equal teams. How many students are on each team?

Answer: $42 \div 6 = 7$ students

5. A baker makes 28 muffins and packs 4 in each box. How many boxes?

Answer: $28 \div 4 = 7$ boxes

6. 35 stickers are shared equally by 5 children. How many does each get?

Answer: $35 \div 5 = 7$ stickers

Challenge

7. 20 markers are split into groups of 4. How many groups? If one more group of 4 is added, how many markers in all?

Answer: $20 \div 4 = 5$ groups; then 24 markers

8. 13 apples are shared equally by 4 children. How many does each get, and how many are left over?

Answer: 3 each, with 1 left over
