

Spring Fractions Worksheet - Answer Key

3rd Grade - spring fractions of a group | 12 minutes

Write the fraction for each part, then compare fractions using $>$, $<$, or $=$.

Example: 4 of 8 flowers are pink $\rightarrow$ $\frac{4}{8}$ (which simplifies to $\frac{1}{2}$)

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| ① 4 of 8 flowers are pink. What fraction?
Answer: $\frac{4}{8} = \frac{1}{2}$ | ② 6 of 12 tulips bloomed. What fraction?
Answer: $\frac{6}{12} = \frac{1}{2}$ |
| ③ 3 of 9 eggs are blue. What fraction?
Answer: $\frac{3}{9} = \frac{1}{3}$ | ④ 5 of 10 ladybugs are on a leaf. What fraction?
Answer: $\frac{5}{10} = \frac{1}{2}$ |
| ⑤ 2 of 8 kites are red. What fraction?
Answer: $\frac{2}{8} = \frac{1}{4}$ | ⑥ 7 of 14 bees are buzzing. What fraction?
Answer: $\frac{7}{14} = \frac{1}{2}$ |
| ⑦ Write the fraction: 2 parts shaded out of 5.
Answer: $\frac{2}{5}$ | ⑧ 4 of 6 ducks are in the water. What fraction?
Answer: $\frac{4}{6} = \frac{2}{3}$ |
| ⑨ 9 of 12 frogs are green. What fraction?
Answer: $\frac{9}{12} = \frac{3}{4}$ | ⑩ 1 of 10 eggs is gold. What fraction?
Answer: $\frac{1}{10}$ |
| ⑪ Which is bigger: $\frac{3}{4}$ or $\frac{1}{4}$?
Answer: $\frac{3}{4}$ | ⑫ Name a fraction equal to $\frac{4}{8}$.
Answer: $\frac{1}{2}$ (equivalent) |

Challenge

- ⑬ Sam has 8 kites; 6 are flying. What fraction is flying? Simplify it.
Answer: $\frac{6}{8} = \frac{3}{4}$
- ⑭ Write a fraction equal to one whole.
Answer: Sample: $\frac{4}{4}$, $\frac{5}{5}$
