3rd Grade - the 10 times table | 7 minutes

Multiply by 10. Write the number, then add a zero in the ones place.

Example: $10 \times 7 = 70$.

1. $10 \times 1 =$

Answer: 10

2. $10 \times 2 =$

Answer: 20

3. $10 \times 3 =$

Answer: 30

4. $10 \times 4 =$

Answer: 40

5. $10 \times 5 =$

Answer: 50

6. $10 \times 6 =$

Answer: 60

7. $10 \times 7 =$

Answer: 70

8. $10 \times 8 =$

Answer: 80

9. $10 \times 9 =$

Answer: 90

10. $10 \times 10 =$

Answer: 100

11. $10 \times 11 =$

Answer: 110

12. $10 \times 12 =$

Answer: 120

Challenge

13. A dime is 10 cents. How much are 8 dimes?

Answer: $10 \times 8 = 80$ cents

14. Why does 10×6 end in a zero?

Answer: Multiplying by 10 moves each one into the tens place, leaving 0 ones.
