

Back to School Multiplication Word Problems - Answer Key

3rd Grade - back to school multiplication word problems | 15 minutes

Read each problem. Write a multiplication sentence and solve. Label your answer.

Example: 7 desks with 4 books each: $7 \times 4 = 28$ books.

1. Each desk has 4 books. How many books are on 7 desks?

Answer: $7 \times 4 = 28$ books

2. A pack has 8 markers. How many markers are in 5 packs?

Answer: $5 \times 8 = 40$ markers

3. The classroom has 6 rows of 5 desks. How many desks?

Answer: $6 \times 5 = 30$ desks

4. Each student needs 3 notebooks. How many notebooks for 9 students?

Answer: $9 \times 3 = 27$ notebooks

5. A box holds 6 glue sticks. How many glue sticks in 8 boxes?

Answer: $8 \times 6 = 48$ glue sticks

6. There are 7 tables with 2 chairs each. How many chairs?

Answer: $7 \times 2 = 14$ chairs

Challenge

7. 9 packs of pencils each hold 6 pencils. How many pencils in all?

Answer: $9 \times 6 = 54$ pencils

8. Each of 5 students gets 3 folders in 2 colors. How many folders in all?

Answer: $5 \times 3 \times 2 = 30$ folders
