

Summer Multiplication Word Problems - Answer Key

3rd Grade - summer multiplication word problems | 15 minutes

Read each problem. Write a multiplication sentence and solve. Label your answer.

Example: 7 coolers with 6 drinks each: $7 \times 6 = 42$ drinks.

1. Each cooler holds 6 drinks. How many drinks in 7 coolers?

Answer: $7 \times 6 = 42$ drinks

2. A pack has 8 popsicles. How many popsicles in 5 packs?

Answer: $5 \times 8 = 40$ popsicles

3. There are 4 rows of 9 beach chairs. How many chairs?

Answer: $4 \times 9 = 36$ chairs

4. Each kid has 3 sand pails. How many pails for 9 kids?

Answer: $9 \times 3 = 27$ pails

5. A crate holds 5 watermelons. How many in 6 crates?

Answer: $6 \times 5 = 30$ watermelons

6. 8 sandcastles each need 2 flags. How many flags in all?

Answer: $8 \times 2 = 16$ flags

Challenge

7. There are 6 coolers with 8 drinks each. How many drinks in all?

Answer: $6 \times 8 = 48$ drinks

8. Each of 9 kids builds 3 sandcastles. How many sandcastles?

Answer: $9 \times 3 = 27$ sandcastles
