

Rounding to the Nearest 10 and 100 Worksheet - Answer Key

4th Grade - rounding to the nearest 10 and 100 | 15 minutes

Round each number as asked. Look at the digit to the right: 5 or more rounds up, less than 5 rounds down.

Example: Round 47 to the nearest 10: the ones digit is 7 (5 or more), so round up to 50.

1. Round 47 to the nearest 10.

Answer: 50

2. Round 83 to the nearest 10.

Answer: 80

3. Round 65 to the nearest 10.

Answer: 70

4. Round 142 to the nearest 10.

Answer: 140

5. Round 238 to the nearest 100.

Answer: 200

6. Round 461 to the nearest 100.

Answer: 500

7. Round 350 to the nearest 100.

Answer: 400

8. Round 619 to the nearest 100.

Answer: 600

Challenge

9. A number rounds to 70 when rounded to the nearest 10. Write one number it could be.

Answer: Answers will vary: any number 65-74 (e.g., 68).

10. Why does 350 round to 400 and not 300 (to the nearest 100)?

Answer: The tens digit is 5, which is halfway, so we round up.
