

Prefixes and Suffixes Worksheet Set 2 - Answer Key

4th Grade - prefixes and suffixes (affixes), set 2 | 18 minutes

Add the prefix or suffix to the root word, write the new word, and tell what it means.

Example: dis- + agree -> disagree (to not agree)

- 1 dis- + appear
Answer: disappear - to not appear / go away
- 2 over- + cook
Answer: overcook - to cook too much
- 3 under- + ground
Answer: underground - below the ground
- 4 im- + possible
Answer: impossible - not possible
- 5 enjoy + -able
Answer: enjoyable - able to be enjoyed
- 6 move + -ment
Answer: movement - the act of moving
- 7 collect + -ion
Answer: collection - a group gathered together
- 8 teach + -er
Answer: teacher - a person who teaches
- 9 invent + -or
Answer: inventor - a person who invents
- 10 dis- + connect
Answer: disconnect - to separate / not connected
- 11 under- + cook
Answer: undercook - to cook too little
- 12 agree + -ment
Answer: agreement - the act of agreeing

Challenge

- 13 Add a prefix AND a suffix to 'use' to make a new word.

Answer: reusable - able to be used again

- 14 How does the suffix -er or -or change a verb like 'teach'?

Answer: It turns the verb into a noun that names the person who does it.
