

Kindergarten Word Problems (Add & Subtract to 10) - Answer Key

Kindergarten - addition and subtraction story problems within 10 | 12 minutes

Read each story. Draw a picture or use counters. Then write the number answer.

Example: 3 ducks are in the pond. 2 more come. How many now? $3 + 2 = 5$ ducks.

1. There are 4 apples. Mom puts 3 more in the bowl. How many apples now?

Answer: 7 apples

2. 5 birds sit on a fence. 2 fly away. How many birds are left?

Answer: 3 birds

3. Sam has 2 red blocks and 4 blue blocks. How many blocks in all?

Answer: 6 blocks

4. There are 8 cookies. The kids eat 5. How many cookies are left?

Answer: 3 cookies

5. 3 cats are on the rug. 3 more come. How many cats in all?

Answer: 6 cats

6. There are 6 balloons. 2 pop. How many balloons are left?

Answer: 4 balloons

7. There are 9 fish. 4 swim away. How many fish are left?

Answer: 5 fish

8. Lia has 5 stickers and gets 5 more. How many does she have?

Answer: 10 stickers
