Example: 4 of 8 flowers are pink $\rightarrow$ $\frac{4}{8}$ (which simplifies to $\frac{1}{2}$)

③ 3 of 9 eggs are blue. What fraction?

④ 5 of 10 ladybugs are on a leaf. What fraction?
