Read each problem. Show both steps, then write the final answer with its label.

Example: Leo has 3 five-dollar bills. He spends \$6: $3 \times 5 = 15$, then $15 - 6 = \$9$.

- ① Leo has 3 five-dollar bills. He spends \$6 on a toy. How much money does he have left?

- ② A baker uses 4 trays with 9 cookies each. He gives 15 cookies away. How many cookies are left?

- ③ There are 27 students in a line. 6 walk away. The rest form 3 equal teams. How many in each team?

- ④ Mia saved \$40. She spent \$16, then split the rest equally into 4 jars. How much in each jar?

- ⑤ A train has 5 cars with 6 passengers each. 9 passengers get off. How many stay on the train?

- ⑥ A farmer has 24 eggs and puts 6 in each carton. He sells 1 carton. How many cartons are left?

- ⑦ School starts at 8:00. Reading takes 45 minutes and math takes 30 minutes. At what time does math end?

- ⑧ A garden has 6 rows of 7 tulips and 4 rows of 5 daffodils. How many flowers in all?

- ⑨ A shop has 5 boxes with 10 erasers each. It sells 12 erasers, then splits the rest into 2 bags. How many erasers in each bag?
